The Tallink Hotels Cup 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and all respective ISU Communications and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2024/2025

Participation in Tallink Hotels Cup is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 on any update of this communication

- **REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES**

Entries should be submitted by clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU

Each club may enter **any number** competitors in each category (males and females). In case of too many entries, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

NB! All Members who are entering competitors first time to the Sportity Online Registration System, must contact Sportity Ltd. by email info@sportity.com with the Members' (Clubs) Country, Organisation Legal Name, National Registry code, contact e-mail address. Please ensure you have enough time to create an initial account. The process might take up to 24 hours.

The "**Planned Program Content**" will be submitted in the Sportity Online Registration System. It is mandatory that the Program Content is filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication

Deadline of entries

Preliminary entry forms must be submitted by **January 6, 2025** at the latest.

Entries that are sent/received after the mentioned deadline will not be accepted.

Entries of Judges

The foreign club who enters 10 or more skaters is kindly asked to bring a Judge (of at least ISU International level) to the Competition. It is also allowed to bring a Judge if the number of skaters is less than 10.

Entries of Judges must be made together with the entries for Competitors in the Sportity Registration System.

In case a judge is sent by a competitor/club, the latter is responsible for the judge's transportation expenses.

- **ENTRY FEE** :

85 EUR for the skaters with one program

Each club has to pay 100% of the total amount for its participant's right after the entry form confirmation, but not later than **January 6, 2025**. The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs. Entry fees are not refunded.

- ✓ We kindly ask the clubs to make **one payment** for all its participants.
- ✓ Please ensure that we receive the net amount of the required payment sum.
- ✓ All registration-related procedures (registration, annulment, changes) must be submitted to the Event Coordinator in written form.
- ✓ In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Entry fees are not refunded.
- ✓ Participating teams should inform of any changes in their team as soon as possible, but not later than **February 1, 2025**

- **AWARDS**

- Three first standings of each category/class shall be awarded with a cup and a special price
- All competitors shall receive a diploma.
- Voucher for photos for each competitor.

- **EXPENSES**

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

Judges, Referees and Technical Panel

The Organizer will provide accommodation and meals for all Referees, Judges drawn for the panel, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators of the International competition.

- **MUSIC and Planned Program Content**

Music files and music information should be submitted in the **Sportity Online Registration System** and it will be reproduced from the computer during the competitions. Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file or a CD.

- **COMPETITION SCHEDULE**

Mandate time: February 11, 2025
All participating clubs are asked to check all their entries in the system.

Opening draws: An electronic Opening draw will be done on February 11 (after the mandate). The starting orders and the final time schedule shall be published in the Sportity Application and on the competition website <http://www.tallinkhotelscup.com/> on the same evening.

*NB! Preliminary schedule will be available after February 1, 2025 at the Tallink Hotels Cup website and a detailed time schedule will be available approx. **1 week** before the competition at the same website <http://www.tallinkhotelscup.com/> and Sportity App.*

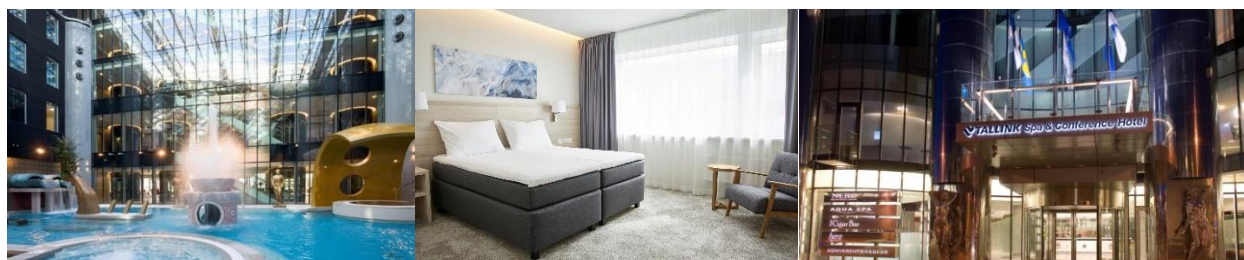
