The Tallink Hotels Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024 the Special Regulations Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2025/2026

Participation in the Tallink Hotels Cup 2026 is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and its member Clubs, and qualify for eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a). They meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation or its Member Clubs.

**Advanced Novice** Men / Women. In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 and ISU Communication 2699 or any update.

**Intermediate Novice** Boys / Girls In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communications 2699 and subsequent updates.

**Basic Novice** Boys / Girls In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communications 2699 and subsequent updates.

**Cubs** Boys / Girls born in 2015/2016, A & B class  
In accordance with Estonian Skating Union Classification for Season 2025/2026. (See Technical Data Details)  
**Free Skating:** 2.30 min (+/-10 sec.)

**Chicks** Boys / Girls born in 2017/2018, A & B class  
In accordance with Estonian Skating Union Classification for Season 2025/2026. (See Technical Data Details)  
**Free Skating:** 2 min. (+/-10 sec.)

**Pre – Chicks** Boys / Girls born in 2019 and younger, A & B class  
In accordance with Estonian Skating Union Classification for Season 2025/2026. (See Technical Data Details)  
**Free Skating:** 2 min. (+/-10 sec.)

**Novice B** Boys / Girls born after 01.07.2009, B class  
In accordance with Estonian Skating Union Classification for Season 2025/2026. (See Technical Data Details)  
Age: before 1 of July of the current season has not reached the age of 16  
**Free Skating:** 3.00 min. (+/-10 sec.)

**Springs B** Boys / Girls born in 2013/2014, B class

**Free Skating:** 2.30 min. (+/-10 sec.)

- **REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES**

All entries to the Tallink Hotels Cup 2026 should be submitted by clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU

Each club may enter **any number** competitors in each category (males and females). In case of too many entries, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

**NB!** All Members who are entering competitors first time to the Sportity Online Registration System, must contact Sportity Ltd. by email [info@sportity.com](mailto:info@sportity.com) with the Members' (Clubs) Country, Organisation Legal Name, National Registry code, contact e-mail address. Please ensure you have enough time to create an initial account. The process might take up to 24 hours.

The "**Planned Program Content**" will be submitted in the Sportity Online Registration System. It is mandatory that the Program Content is filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication

### **Deadline of entries**

Preliminary entry forms must be submitted by **January 5, 2026** at the latest.

**Entries that are sent/received after the mentioned deadline will not be accepted.**

- **ENTRY FEE:**

**90 EUR** for the skaters with one program

**110 EUR** for the skaters with two programs

Each club has to pay 100% of the total amount for its participant's right after the entry form confirmation, but not later than **January 6, 2026**. The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs. Entry fees are not refunded.

All Entry Fee payments received after 23:59 local time, January 6, 2026 are subject to a late entry fee of 10€ per skater. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation or Club is substituting a skater, whose entry fee was paid by the deadline by another skater. The OC reserves the right to cancel the Entry of skaters whose entry fee has not been paid by the published deadline.

- ✓ We kindly ask the clubs to make **one payment** for all its participants.
- ✓ Please ensure that we receive the net amount of the required payment sum.
- ✓ All registration-related procedures (registration, annulment, changes) must be submitted to the Event Coordinator in written form.
- ✓ In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Entry fees are not refunded.
- ✓ Participating teams should inform of any changes in their team as soon as possible, but not later than **February 1, 2026**

- **AWARDS**

- Three first standings of each category/class shall be awarded with a cup and a special price
- All competitors shall receive a diploma.
- Voucher for photos for each competitor.

- **EXPENSES**

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

## **Judges, Referees and Technical Panel**

The Organizer will provide accommodation and meals for all Referees, Judges drawn for the panel, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators of the International competition.

- **MUSIC and Planned Program Content**

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee through the Sportity Online Registration System ( <https://fs.sportity.com/>) by latest January 19 2026.

The submission must be of a fine quality encoded in either MP3 or WAV format with normalised level audio. The OC cannot guarantee quality playback for music submitted in other than the above-mentioned format. Each music submission must also contain the name of the track, composer, singer and/or author in the Title field of the Online Registration form.

In accordance to the Estonian Skating Federation rules as well as the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024 the Special Regulations Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 **each skater and his/her lawful representative is solely responsible for the music rights and licenses for their program's music.** The OC will take no responsibility for licensing the program/performance music.

- **Results**

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024 , Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Intermediate and final results will be published on competition website and in Sportity App event channel.

There will be no hard-copy distribution of any printed media on this event. All required information will be available on the Information Board at the Ice Rink and on Digital Info Board (Sportity App)

- **COMPETITION SCHEDULE**

Time Schedule will be announced after the deadline of entry forms. Time Schedule will be published in the Sportity App and on a competition website (<https://tallinkhotelscup.ee>).
